Annex 11 for Computerised Systems is the regulation for both the European Union and counties working under PIC/S GMP (Pharmaceutical Inspection Cooperation Scheme), it was originally issued in 1992 and upgraded in 2011. A

concept paper on the revision of Annex 11 contains a proposal published by EU and PIC/S to revise Annex 11 containing 33 areas for update and extension to include a control framework for Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (AI/ML).
